

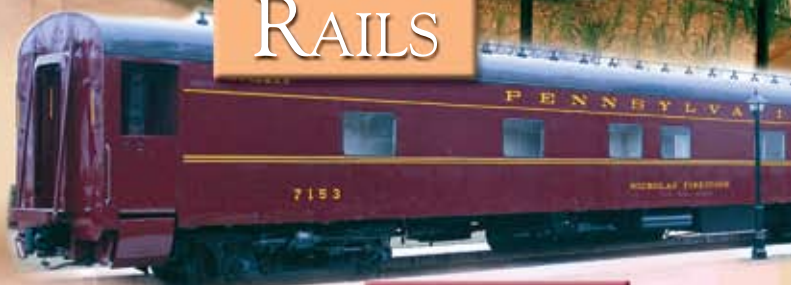

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE PETER HERDIC TRANSPORTATION MUSEUM**

**From the North:** Take U.S. Route 15 South to Williamsport's Maynard Street Exit. Turn left onto Maynard St., turn right onto West Fourth St., turn left onto Trinity Place.

**From the South:** Take U.S. Route 15 North to Williamsport which turns into Market Street, turn left onto West Fourth Street, go less than 1 mile and turn right onto Trinity Place.

**From the East:** Take Interstate 80 West to Interstate 180 to Williamsport's Maynard St. Exit, turn right onto Maynard St., turn right onto West Fourth St., turn left onto Trinity Place.

**From the West:** Take Interstate 80 East to Interstate 180 follow 180/ U.S. 220 North to Williamsport's Maynard Street Exit. Turn left onto Maynard St., turn right onto West Fourth St., turn left onto Trinity Place.
